Designed to enhance global awareness and improve your employability





### INTRODUCTION

The Global Skills Award is a unique programme designed to enhance global awareness and improve your employability in a competitive job market, while you study for your Master's Degree.

Studying for a taught Master's Degree will improve your detailed knowledge of your academic subject; it may also provide preparation for a professional career. A postgraduate degree is highly likely to improve your employment prospects, and the Global Skills Award Programme gives you the opportunity to take your career one step further.

The Global Skills Award Programme is designed to broaden your understanding of global issues and current affairs, as well as develop personal skills to enhance your employability. The Programme runs from October to May and is free of charge. All students registered for a taught Master's Degree are eligible to enrol. Once enrolled on to the programme you will undertake a personal development assessment, which will help you to reflect on your skills and identify any areas in need of development.

You will attend a lecture series delivered by leading academics and specialists. This will give you the opportunity to participate in discussions about issues of global importance, such as the environment, culture, social changes, world politics and gender. A series of skills training workshops will offer you the chance to develop your career opportunities, as well as acquire the skills you need to succeed in the workplace, such as team working, networking and leadership.

The Global Skills Award Programme will give you the opportunity to broaden your experience and gain important skills whilst you are studying. It will also provide a fantastic opportunity to meet and network with other postgraduate students from a wide variety of backgrounds and disciplines.



## LECTURES AND EVENTS

At the heart of the Global Skills Award Programme is the series of lectures and events. These lectures are an ideal opportunity to network with other postgraduate students and discuss topics of interest from outside your own discipline.

Lectures and events on the Global Skills Award Programme take place from October to April, and are bookable through our training portal at: https://grctraining.targetconnect.net

Due to the unprecedented circumstances of COVID-19, we intend to run the majority of events online and a small proportion face-to-face, to enhance accessibility for all students. Where lectures are held in person, they will take place at 18.00 on the Canterbury campus.

To be eligible for an award you will need to attend at least three lectures/events.

The lecture series will begin with an online introductory lecture hosted by Professor Paul Allain, Dean of the Graduate and Researcher College. This will run as part of the Virtual Employability Festival in October

The lecture series will feature a variety of topics such as: Culture; Global Citizenship; Gender and Politics.

As part of the lecture and event series, we will hold a networking event, where you will have the opportunity to practice your networking skills.

- 3 Attend workshops from the workshop series
- 4 Once you have attended all the workshops and lectures you wish to, complete a final Global Skills Award evaluation form

#### **Award levels**

The table below shows the number of lectures and workshops you need to attend in order to gain a specific level of award.

The minimum requirement is to attend three lectures and workshops for a Bronze Award.
