## The Partner Scholarship

The Partner Scholarship extends our support for students from local schools and colleges by rewarding those who will make the most positive contribution to the University community.

The Scholarship is worth £1,000 for each year of study and is awarded to eligible students who have applied to the University of Kent for an undergraduate programme which requires the payment of full tuition fees.

## Who is eligible?

You can apply for the Partner Scholarship if you are a UK or EU student currently studying:

- at a University of Kent partner school or college
- at a school in the University of Kent Academies Trust (UKAT)
- on the University of Kent's Access to HE Diploma
- on the University of Kent's University Entrance Diploma.

## Facts about scholarships and stipends

- They do *not* have to be repaid – they are awarded purely on merit.
- They are not based on household income and don't affect your student loan.
- You can hold more than one scholarship or stipend at a time.



## The Student Ambassador Stipend

Student Ambassador Stipends have been created for students who have an interest in becoming involved in outreach work during their undergraduate studies. Successful applicants receive an award of £1,000 a year, alongside an exclusive programme of training and work experience specifically designed to enhance their employability skills.

### The benefits of holding a Student Ambassador Stipend

In addition to their financial award, holders of Student Ambassador Stipends receive regular training to develop the skills necessary

to support and, eventually, deliver a range of activities in schools and colleges. They gain valuable experience through a variety of outreach work, which becomes increasingly varied and challenging as their skills progress.

### Who is eligible?

You can apply for a stipend if you are a UK or EU student currently studying:

- at a University of Kent partner school or college, including members of the Kent and Medway Progression Federation
- at a school in the University of Kent Academies Trust (UKAT)

- on the University of Kent's Access to HE Diploma
- on the University of Kent's University Entrance Diploma.
