In 2022, IJP will once again offer an exclusive opportunity to students from KSU partner universities to study the Japanese language and connect directly with KSU students, Japan and their international peers during a two week study and adventure filled program.

Dates: June 20 – July 2, 2022

Japanese class levels : JLPT N4 / N3 / N2 or equivalent

Japanese class times: Weekdays 19:00 to 21:00 (JST)

Participation Fee: 20,000yen (text book fee not included)

Participants will -

- **Receive 20 hours** of intensive Japanese language instruction
- **Chat regularly** with KSU conversation partners
- **Enjoy on-line events** with KSU students. (Advertised events and activities are subject to change.)
- **Learn about Kyoto**, a hub of **Japanese culture**
- **Understand** more about student **life in Japan**

Note:

- *A minimum of 15 participants is required for the program to run.
- *A minimum of 5 participants is required for each class to be opened.
- *A maximum of 15 participants will be accepted into any one class.
- *Maximum of 20 participants accepted into the program.

How to Apply

Step 1: Students interested in participating in IJP should first contact the international office at their home university, ask to be nominated and provide their home university with the following details.

- Name (As in passport)
- Gender (used for matching KSU students)
- Level of Japanese proficiency according to JLPT system
Note that this program will be aimed at students looking to next attain JLPT N4, N3 or N2.
- Reason for applying (Up to 50 words In English, or 50 characters in Chinese or Japanese)
- E-mail address.

Step 2: The student's home university nominates interested students to KSU by **March 1, 2022**

Step 3: Students accepted by KSU will be sent application forms. Application Deadline **March 31, 2022**

Step 4: Pay IJP fees to KSU (Details will be sent to successful applicants.)

Step 5: Join IJP

Note:

- Participation is limited to a maximum of 20 students. All participants must be enrolled in a KSU partner university.
- Up to 3 students from any individual KSU partner university may be nominated. Acceptance of more than 3 students will be considered subject to availability at the close of the nomination period.
- Only nominations for students whose levels of Japanese language proficiency are within the target levels for the program will be considered.
- KSU will select 20 participants from those students nominated and provide them with application details.
- Nominations will close on March 1 or when 20 successful nominations have been received.
