Whatever your discipline, poster presentations are a powerful and widely used means of disseminating research in both academic and non-academic contexts. Distilling your research into a poster that is engaging and visually appealing is an excellent way to stretch your creativity and demonstrate the impact of your work.

Guidance and Criteria Poster Guidelines:

- Only one poster allowed per entrant. Posters must relate to an aspect of the entrant's research.
- The printed poster should be A1 in portrait or landscape or A0 in portrait only (A0 landscape will not fit on poster display boards).
- It is the responsibility of competition entrants to ensure that any images used in their poster are not copyrighted.

Judging Criteria for Competition:

Posters will be assessed according to two criteria:

- Poster design – presentation and visual communication.
- Research content – how easily this can be understood by non-subject specialists.

You must be able to display your Poster at the GRC Annual Postgraduate Conference Wednesday 7 June in Sibson Atrium, Canterbury Campus.

How to apply

1. Register your interest here: [Research Poster](#). The deadline is 22 May.
2. Print your poster so that it can be displayed at the Kent Researchers' Showcase on Wednesday 7 June in the Sibson Atrium, Canterbury campus.
3. The printed poster should be A1 in portrait or landscape or A0 in portrait only (A0 landscape will not fit on poster display boards). Printed posters do not have to be laminated. One poster per entrant and the subject should relate to an aspect of the entrants research at Kent.
