Guidance and Criteria

Photo Guidelines:

- A photograph which reflects or captures your research.
- Photographs can be printed in landscape or portrait orientation, no more than A1 in size.
- The entry should be a single photograph. No multiple or collage images are allowed.
- It is the responsibility of competition entrants to ensure that any images used are not copyrighted and belong to the entrant. Note that any photographs, which infringe the copyrights of a third party or contain provocative, defamatory, sexually explicit, or otherwise objectionable or inappropriate content will be disqualified.

Judging Criteria for Competition:

Photographs will be assessed according to two criteria:

- Creative interpretation of the research and it's visual communication.
- Research content does it intrigue, inform and engage nonsubject specialists.

You must be able to display your photograph at the GRC Annual Postgraduate Conference Wednesday 7 June in Sibson Atrium, Canterbury Campus.

- 3. Print your photograph so that it can be displayed at the Kent Researchers' Showcase on Wednesday 7 June in the Sibson Atrium, Canterbury campus. The printed photograph should be between A3 and A1 in size for maximum impact.
