

## Reading list guide

# Adding journal articles and other online resources

You do not need to be editing your reading list in order to use the bookmark tool.

- 1 Find your online resource. For journal articles we recommend finding your article through LibrarySearch or one of the databases available through the library – this is because Talis can only recognise items that have specific metadata attached and will not work with PDFs.
- 2 When your chosen article has been opened click on the Talis browser extension: top right of toolbar.
