




MSc Business Analytics Class profile 2022 - 23

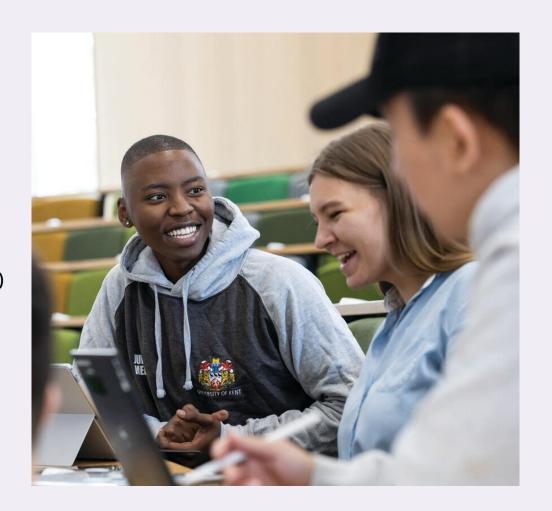

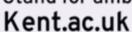
