### **Phishing Emails - HMRC**



Action Fraud have reported that they have received over 440 reports of fake emails impersonation HMRC, offering a Tax "refund." As always, they ask you to click on a link in the email, which will take you to a genuine looking website but which is under the control of the fraudsters, who are looking to steal your personal and financial data.

HMRC will NEVER send you a email like this requesting you click on a link to obtain a tax rebate and asking for that type of information.



# Criminals target the public with fake HMRC tax refund emails

We've received 442 reports in two weeks about fake emails purporting to be from HMRC. The emails state that the recipient is owed a tax refund (rebate), and the links provided in the emails lead to genuine-looking phishing websites that are designed to steal personal and financial information.

- HMRC will never send notifications of a tax rebate or ask you to disclose personal or payment information by email.
