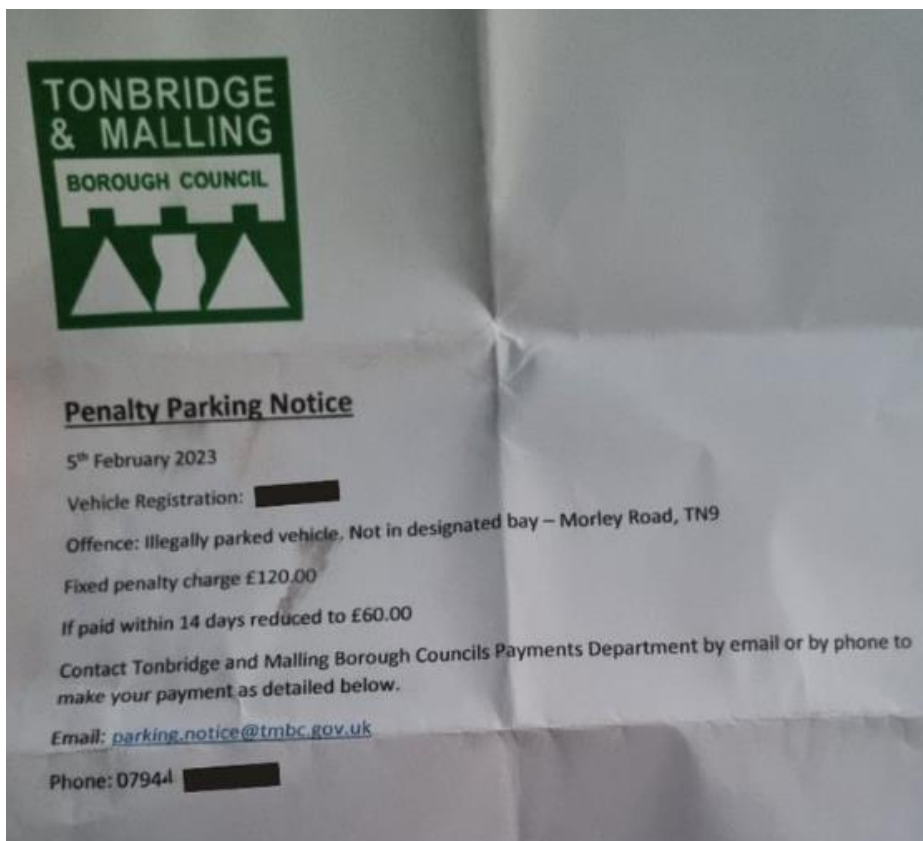

Fake Parking Ticket

Tunbridge and Malling Borough Council had the below fake parking ticket reported to them by someone who had parked their vehicle in Morley Road, Tonbridge. Although this was in Tonbridge, scammers are always likely to try this scam elsewhere in the county.
