Year in...


Take a specialised year in another subject such as Languages, Data Analytics, or Computing etc.

One year of full-time study to develop skills and knowledge required prior to your undergraduate degree.

Entry Criteria



Typical entry requirements are: 128 UCAS points A Level: ABB

BTEC Extended Diploma: DDD - DDM

International Baccalaureate: 32 points overall or 16 points at HL.

All courses require English & Maths GCSE at least Grade C/4 or equivalent. Our quantitative courses require Maths GCSE at Grade B/6.

Foundation Year - 72 UCAS points A Level: DDD

BTEC Nationals: MMP














Postgraduate courses at KBS

Entry Criteria



It depends on the programme but typically a minimum of a second-class UK degree, or an equivalent internationally recognised qualification, is needed.

English IELTS 6.0 with a minimum of 5.5 in each component.

All applicants are considered on an individual basis and additional academic qualifications, professional qualifications and relevant experience may also be taken into account when considering applications.




