Undergraduate Scholarships







- £6000 towards the tuition fees for up to three years of study (subject to achieving 60% average in first two years)
- There is just one round, and the deadline is: Friday 28 March 2025, 17:00 GMT
- Students should have at least AAA at A level or equivalent overseas qualification.
- Students must have received a conditional or unconditional offer to be able to submit their scholarship application
- Students must make Kent their firm choice by the deadline for their application to be considered
- Students who are taking a foundation degree as part of their degree are not eligible to apply.
- This is stackable/combinable with other scholarships to a max of 50% of tuition fee.
- Further information





- £2,000 tuition fee discount per year for 2 years of study (subject to satisfactory academic progress).
- The deadline for this scholarship is 31st July 2025.
- Applicants must be self-funded and have completed, or be completing, a first Bachelor's degree, achieved with a first-class or equivalent
- Been made and accepted an offer of a place on the Law (Graduate Entry) LLB and submitted a scholarship application by the scholarship application deadline.
- This award cannot be held in conjunction with other awards and scholarships
 offered by Kent Law School, and the award which provides the greater monetary
 value overall will be given only. Please contact the scholarships team

Postgraduate Taught & Postgraduate Research Scholarships



International Scholarships for Taught Masters students



- £6000 towards the tuition fees for one year of study, available for students beginning their degrees in September, across all campuses and centres
- Round 1 deadline: 28th March 2025, 17:00 GMT
- There will be a second round, which will open after Round 1 is complete
- Students must hold a UK First Class Honours degree or equivalent overseas qualification
- Students must have received a conditional or unconditional offer for one of our full time PGT courses, to be able to **submit their scholarship application**
- Students must have accepted their offer from Kent by the deadline for their application to be considered
- This is stackable/combinable with other scholarships to a max of 50% of tuition fee.

British Council GREAT Scholarship: China, France, Kenya, Malaysia, Nigeria, Thailand and Turkey



- Funded jointly by the UK Government's Study UK GREAT Britain campaign, British Council and the University of Kent
- £10,000 towards the tuition fees for one year of study
- Students must submit an essay via their portal, 500 words about: "a topic you have studied previously and why you found it interesting. This topic should be related to or have inspired you to apply for your chosen degree programme."
- Application deadline: Friday 25th April 2025 17:00 BST
- Change to eligibility: Applicants must have Chinese, French, Kenyan, Malaysian, Nigerian, Thai or Turkish nationality, and be living in the same country (overseas fee payers). These countries change each year
- Applicants must be active in the field with work experience or proven interest in the subject area, and be willing to act as an ambassador for UK Higher Education
- Students must have received a conditional or unconditional offer for a one year taught masters
 programme at one of our UK campuses, to be able to submit their scholarship application. Students who
 have applied for a Year in Industry aren't eligible.
- Students must have accepted their offer from Kent by the deadline for their application to be considered

The Bestway Foundation Scholarship (for Pakistani students)



- 6 scholarships of £26,000 (Tuition fees plus maintenance).
- Applicants must have received a conditional or unconditional offer for one of our Postgraduate one year Masters programmes in Science, Technology and Mathematics.
- Open to students from, and domiciled in, Pakistan
- Applicants will be shortlisted based on their academic performance.
- Shortlisted applicants will also be considered on the basis of financial need.
- Award is not available for students applying for PhD programmes, the International Incorporated Masters, or Masters programmes that include a year in industry.
- Candidates must be available for video interview, via Microsoft Teams, to be held in June 2025, exact date to be confirmed, and this is subject to be changed.
- To allow time for programme applications to be processed:
- Students applying for research masters courses should apply for a course no later than Friday 18th April 2025.
- Students applying for taught postgraduate courses should apply for a course no later than Friday 9th May 2025.
- Scholarship application deadline: Friday 23rd May 2025, 17:00 BST

- £3,000 for Full Time Overseas students
- Deadline: 16th July 2025, 23:59 BST
- Eligible candidates must be progressing directly from undergraduate to postgraduate study at Kent and due to start in September 2025.
- Have achieved at least a 2.1 in undergraduate programme.
- Have received an unconditional offer for a programme by the deadline.
- Postgraduate Taught or Research Master's programmes are eligible.

Kent Law School LLM Global Welcome Scholarship (Canterbury), September 2025 entry



- £2,500 tuition fee discount
- Deadline to apply: 31st July 2025, 23:59 BST
- For overseas students from any country which receives Official Development Assistance (ODA) from the OECD. A full list of countries can be found on the OECD website, which can be found on our scholarships page.
- Must have applied for the taught Kent LLM at the Canterbury Campus of the University of Kent for September 2025 entry
- To have accepted an offer of a place on the taught LLM by the scholarship application deadline
- Eligibility for the award will be assessed after an application has been submitted via our Kent Application portal.

- Must meet academic conditions of entry to receive the award and Kent graduates are eligible if criteria are met.

Thailand Second LLM Scholarship - Law (Canterbury), September 2025 Entry



- £3,000 tuition fee discount
- Deadline: 31st July 2025, 23:59 BST
- Applicants must hold a valid passport demonstrating that they hold Thai nationality.
- Must have applied for a second taught Kent LLM at the Canterbury Campus of the University of Kent for September 2025 entry.
- Must have been made an offer of a place on the second taught LLM by the scholarship application deadline.
- Submit a scholarship application before the deadline.
- Must meet academic conditions of entry to receive the award and Kent graduates are eligible if criteria are met.

India Women in Leadership Scholarship



- 50% of the tuition fees for one year of study
- Deadline: Friday 23rd May 2025, 5pm BST
- Open to female students from, and domiciled in India.
- Applicants must have received a conditional or unconditional offer for a full-time taught masters programme by the deadline in order to be considered for the award.
- Candidates must be available for video interview, via Microsoft Teams, to be held in the week commencing 9 June 2025, the exact date to be confirmed, which is subject to change.
- Applicants will be shortlisted based on their academic performance.
- To allow time for programme applications to be processed students should apply for a course no later than Friday 9 May 2025

Scholarships for PHD students



- Some Schools offer PhD scholarships for any topic, but in the Sciences, funding is available for research on a particular topic. Always best to check the course page of the course you wish to apply for to see if the school is offering any funded projects.
- Kent Law School PHD Global Welcome (Canterbury):
- A tuition fee discount scholarship of £5,000. This scholarship will be available for three years of full-time, registered PhD study.
 - -Deadline to apply and to receive an offer by is 13th June 2025 23:59 BST.
- Decisions about scholarship allocation will be based on the quality of PhD application and the applicant's potential to make a positive contribution to the research culture and environment of Kent Law School.
- Once the scholarship has been offered, applicants are required to pay their tuition fee deposit by 31st July 2025, 23.59 BST, in order to secure the scholarship.
- Have applied for the PhD in Law or PhD in Socio-Legal Studies at the Canterbury Campus of the University of Kent for September 2025 entry.

Scholarships for PHD students



Philip Robinson Scholarship

- A maximum of four scholarships in French Literature and Culture for September 2025 entry.
- Includes a doctoral stipend (equivalent to the Research Councils UK National Minimum Doctoral Stipend, 2025/26 rate is £20,780) tuition fees at the home or international rate and access to a research training support grant.
- Application deadline: Monday 31st March, 23:59 BST.
- Open to applicants looking to study for a PhD in French Literature and Culture with the Language Centre in the School of Humanities.
- BSc in a relevant subject.
- MA qualifications are desirable.
- In order to apply, applicants are required to complete an application on Kent Vision. This will include a research proposal explaining their project, a personal statement, a CV, an academic transcript and the names of two referees.

University of Kent

Undergraduate Scholarship (UG) - Kent Kent International Academic Excellence Award (KIAEA)

- £3,000 tuition fee waiver for Year 1 + £1,000 per year in Years 2 & 3 (subject to grades).
- Open to students from 22 countries, including UAE, Kenya, China, India, Canada & more.
- Awarded based on academic excellence (AAB or ABB grades required).
- Available for September 2025 & September 2026 entry only.
- Latest deposit date: 31st July (year of entry).
- Award cannot be used in conjunction with another scholarship (except by exception)
- Excludes Medicine & Pharmacy courses.

Postgraduate Scholarships (PGT) - Kent Future Students Scholarships (KFSS)



£2,000 - £5,000 tuition fee waivers for students from:

- Africa (£3,000)
- India (£5,000)
- Pakistan (£5,000)
- Global regions including MENA, East Asia, Europe, Southeast Asia, and North America (£2,000)
- Automatic consideration upon receiving an offer.
- Open for both September 2025 & January 2026 intakes.
- Deposit deadline: 31st July (Sept entry) | 5th Dec (Jan entry).
- · Scholarship cannot be used in conjunction with another scholarship.
