Fake Emails impersonating NHS/Yodel

A Kent resident has contacted us to make us aware are malicious emails circulating purporting to be from couriers, relating to the delivery of NHS testing kits.

He received one impersonating "Yodel" asking him to forward details back to them so they could deliver a home bowel-screening kit.

He stated that are very realistic, however, when he checked the sending address, it did not match either Yodel or the NHS email addresses.
