## Windows 10 is ending security

You may need to update your windows on your computer.

Official support for Windows 10 ends on 14 October 2025, this means that you will no longer receive fixes, new features or security updates after that date unless you act.

If you do nothing, you will be vulnerable to hackers.

If you have a Windows 10 PC, you are likely already have seen notifications informing you about the end of support. For PCs eligible for Windows 11, this includes the option to upgrade for free.

Not all PCs with Windows 10 will have the necessary specifications to upgrade. If you have a PC running Windows 7 or 8.1 (or one bought with these and later upgraded to Windows 10), you almost certainly will not.
