Terms of Reference

Background

The University of Kent recognises the importance of Technicians and Technical Staff across all areas of the organisation and the vital part they play in delivering the very best student experience, education, internationally recognised research and innovation, and supporting the community as part of the University's civic mission.

Through the national Technician Commitment programme, the University has pledged to support the visibility, recognition, career development, sustainability and impact of all technicians.

Purpose of the group

The Technician Commitment Working Group will jointly oversee, along with the Technical Services Management/Leadership Group, the implementation of the Technician Commitment strategy and action plan. The Technical Manager (Technician Commitment) will provide strategic insight and lead the delivery of the Technician Commitment strategy and action plan, supported by and in collaboration with the Head of Technical Services. Progress will be reported to the Technician Commitment Executive Group Sponsor for dissemination to the wider Executive Group.

Functions of the group

- Oversee and provide directional guidance on Kent's Technician Commitment Strategy and Action Plan and its implementation across the University
- Monitor progress and provide guidance in the delivery of the Technician Commitment, including progress against targets and objectives.
- To develop and support technical leads across the institution to deliver against targets and objectives
- Act as ambassadors for embedding Technician Commitment across Kent's schools, directorates and realm of wider influence
- Ensure that any opportunities are identified relevant to the context of the organisation and incorporated into strategic decision making.

Meetings will be held 3 monthly and be chaired by the Technical Manager (Technician Commitment). Meetings will have actions recorded and an action list produced for all the members following each meeting.
