PGT Scholarships

For students from Bangladesh, China, Hong Kong, India, Indonesia, Malaysia, Nepal, Nigeria, Pakistan, South Korea, Taiwan, Thailand, Türkiye or Vietnam.

£3,000 for Kent Business School students (alongside fees reduced by £4k compared to the previous year)

£5,000 for students on other programmes (exceptions apply)

For all international applicants - £5,000 split across the first two years of the course. £3,000 in the first year, £2,000 in the second. Some course exceptions apply, please check the criteria listed on the scholarships page.

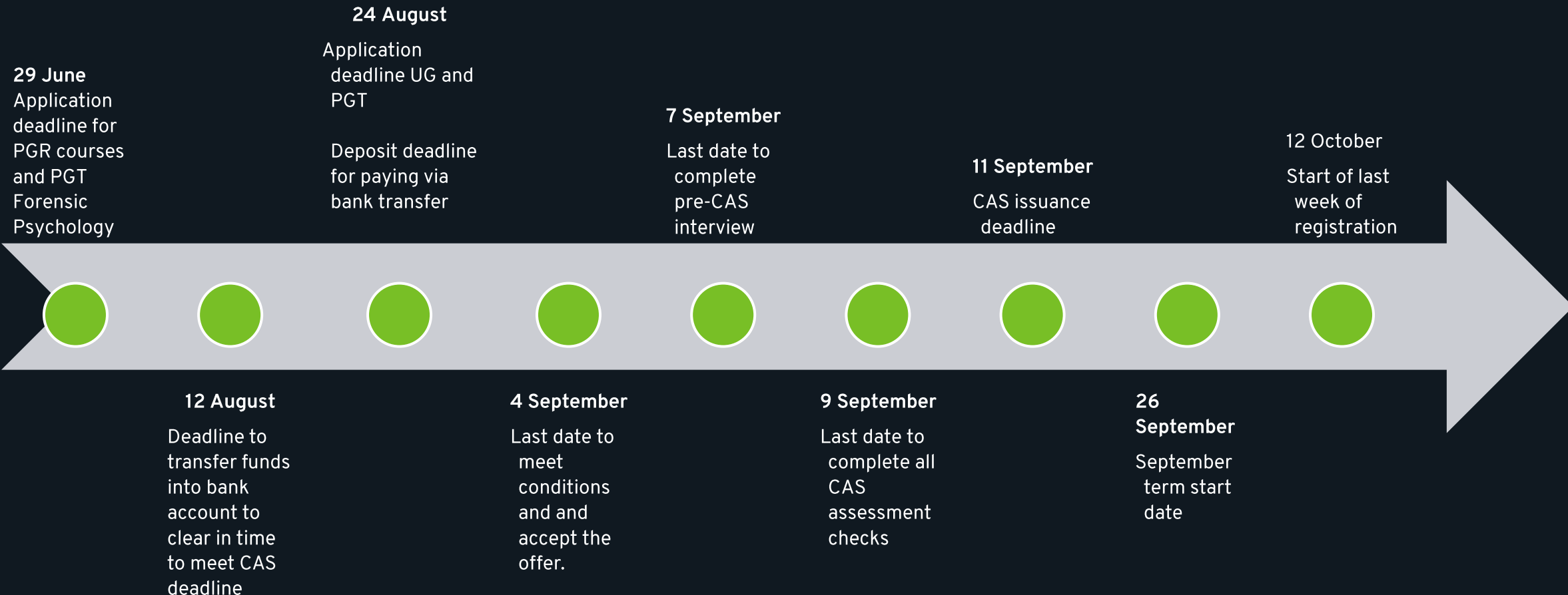
Accommodation: Canterbury and Medway

Applications – UCAS or Agent portal

When a counsellor account is created for you, you will receive an email with a temporary password and a copy of the Agent portal handbook

To log in to the agent portal, please go to: <http://evision.kent.ac.uk>. You will then need to click on 'Applicant login'

To reset the password, you'll need to know the username and surname on the account. Use the DOB 01/Jan/1990.

Key documents include

- Transcripts
- Passport
- Personal Statement
- Reference
 - UG (apart from KBS): 1 x academic reference
 - PGT (apart from KBS) 1 x academic, or 1 x professional if it's +3 years since they studied
 - PGR (including KBS) 2 x academic reference (same rule applies re the 3 years)
 - KBS PGT and UG: No reference is required

English language requirements

Students who studied an undergraduate in English need to submit a Medium of Instruction letter, degree certificate and apply for an ECCTIS academic qualification assessment Statement. For students who register at Kent and successfully used the statement to meet the condition, the cost of the ECCTIS statement will be refunded.

- Pre-sessional English courses available online or on campus between 6-16 weeks. Pre-sessional leaflet for agent (UKVI SELT required for entry) <https://www.kent.ac.uk/international/agents>.
- IELTS
 - Most programmes are 6.0 overall with minimum 5.5 across all bands .
 - Some programmes may ask for higher IELTS (Law, English)
- Wide range of other English language qualifications e.g. Oxford ELLT, Pearson, TOEFL
- GSCE /O Level - Grade 4 / C or above in English Language (no more than 8 years before the start of the course)
- A Levels - Grade C or above in English Language or Literature (no more than 8 years before the start of the course)
- IB – grade 5 or higher at HL in English language or Literature

The University will consider applicants holding/studying BTEC Extended National Diploma Qualifications (QCF; NQF; OCR) in Applied Science or Forensic and Criminal Investigation (must include Unit 15 Practical Chemical Analysis) at DDM.
- International Baccalaureate
120 tariff points - typically H5, H6, H6 including HL Chemistry or Biology 5.
- GCSE
Mathematics grade 4/C

If specific subjects are required, it will be mentioned under 'additional requirements'.

1. Degree requirement

a. GBC status

You must hold, or have applied for Graduate Basis for Chartered Membership with the British Psychological Society (BPS). Please note that Graduate Membership of the BPS is not accepted.

You will normally have GBC status if you hold a Psychology honours degree accredited by the BPS. Otherwise, you can apply to have your existing degree assessed by the BPS, or take a conversion course. If you are not sure whether you hold GBC status, please contact the BPS directly.

b. Adequate level of academic achievement

UK

International

Please see our International Student website for entry requirements by country and other relevant information. Due to visa restrictions, students who require a student visa to study cannot study part-time unless undertaking a distance or blended learning programme with no on-campus provision.

English Language requirements

This course requires a Good level of English language, equivalent to B2 on CEFR.

Details on how to meet this requirement can be found on our English Language requirements webpage.

For international entry requirements

Requirements

CAS requirements

- Unconditional offer
- Minimum deposit of £5000
- Bank statement valid up to 28 days
- Copy of academic documents and travel document

CAS issuance begins from 6 months until deadline (11 September 2026)

Registration requirements

- Paid up to 50% in September - Enrolment (or January for Jan starters)
- Next 50% due by December (or 1 April for January starters)
- Students that want a more flexible plan can split remaining balance of 50% across 3 months.
- Must be enrolled before payment plan can be agreed

The CAS Application Journey



Phase 1: CAS Shield (Data Collection & Assessment) on CAS shield



Step 1: Access – Log in via the unique link in the **Welcome Email** (sent after accepting an Unconditional Offer).



Step 2: Submission – Complete all sections, including the **Financial Plan**, and upload all required documents. Pay the deposit (before or after pre-CAS credibility interview)



Step 3: Interview – Complete any additional questionnaires or record a **Pre-CAS Credibility Interview** if prompted.



Step 4: Evidence – Monitor for requests; additional documents may be required based on initial uploads.

Step 5: Pre-CAS Review – Once assessment is complete in CAS Shield, a Pre-CAS (Draft) is issued on KentVision.

Step 6: Final CAS – After approval, the final CAS Number is issued via KentVision.
